

Dear Camper:

We are so excited that you will be attending our Rangerette Summer Camp at Kilgore College!

New this year, check in will be in the Rangerette Showcase located on Broadway Boulevard. Please check in between 10 and 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 16. You can leave your suitcases in the car during check in. If you are unable to arrive during that time, check in at the front desk of Stark Hall (our high rise dorm).

At registration, if a balance is owed, we request you pay in cash, money order, or cashier's check made payable to Rangerettes Forever, or by credit card (Discover, MasterCard, Visa, American Express). Personal checks will not be accepted at this time. If a copy of your insurance card has not been sent previously, please turn in a copy of it at this time.

When you check in during registration, you will be given your dorm room assignment for Stark Hall. Dorm room assignments should not be changed. Every consideration is being taken to ensure that you get the roommate you requested.

From the Rangerette Showcase, go to your dorm floor to meet your chaperones, find your room, and unpack. After unpacking, please remain on your floor with your chaperones. They will walk with you to lunch which officially starts camp.

Please note that if rules are not adhered to, participants will be sent home prior to the end of the camp.

If the camper is on any kind of medicine, please send it in the original prescription bottle with instructions attached on how and when to take it. If the camper has any health concerns, please write these down and give to her chaperone, along with a phone number where you can be reached at all times.

As a special treat, you can have your photo made with a Rangerette in her uniform for \$8 by a professional photographer when you check in for camp in the Rangerette Showcase. Family and friends may also take advantage of this opportunity.

Camp will close on Saturday. Family and friends are invited to attend a final demonstration on that day to be held in Masters Gymnasium starting at 11 a.m. Guests are asked not to walk on the Masters Gym floor. After final demonstration, parents may pick up their campers in their dorm rooms and then please check out with their chaperones.

While you are in our care, we are providing a nutritious, well-balanced diet in our Devall Student Center cafeteria for breakfast and lunch. Evening meals will be served in the Devall Ballroom and will be brought in from area restaurants. If you have any food allergies, please email Paula Jamerson at pjamerson@kilgore.edu.

Spending money will be needed if you would like to purchase items from the Rangerette Showcase. These start around 75 cents for souvenirs and clothing items cost around \$10 and up. Proceeds from these sales go toward scholarships for our Rangerettes.

**Optional - 1st day of camp, you may wear anything Red, White or Blue;
2nd day of Camp anything with Animal print or Lady bugs;
3rd day of camp anything Blue and Yellow (these are the Rangerette class colors this year and it is always fun to dress like them).
Again these are optional suggestions and NOT required.**

Campers will need all black dance attire for the final demonstration. This could be black shorts/pants and black t-shirt or even the camp t-shirt.

For your dorm room, bring sheets that would fit a twin or extra-long twin size bed, pillow, blanket, towels, soap, etc. Please bring some shoes that you can wear while taking a shower. We recommend you do not bring anything you would not want to lose. Keep your spending money with you at all times as dorm rooms should not be locked. At night besides our chaperones, we will have a security guard on site for the additional safety of our campers.

Also, we request that parents not send flowers, gifts, or mail.

Family and friends are invited to be with us for final demonstration only. Once the camp is underway, parents are requested to not go past the lobby desk in the dorm. If a visit is needed, please contact us at one of the numbers below.

WELCOME TO THE RANGERETTE SUMMER CAMP

Camp Info:

1. Your room number will be given to you when you arrive. You will be staying in Stark Hall this year. Please check in with the chaperone on your floor. Then take your suitcases to your room and unpack.
2. Camp officially starts with lunch. Please stay on your dorm floor until that time. You will go to the cafeteria as a group with your chaperones.
3. **Wear your name tag at all times.** This will be provided for you at check in.
4. **Keep your money with you at all times.** Do not leave it in your room.
5. Wear your all black dance attire for the final demonstration on Saturday (Camp t-shirts may be worn also).
6. Cooperate fully with your chaperone. She is responsible for you.

Dorm Rules:

1. Keep your room and dorm lobby clean. Nothing should be put on the walls of your room or on doors. This is the home of our students during school.
2. No running on stairs or slamming of doors. We don't want anyone to get hurt.
3. Campers in room should keep noise down so you cannot be heard in halls.
4. Do not lock dorm rooms. Chaperones need access to your room at all times.
5. Please enter and leave the dorm through the front door.

General Rules:

1. Do not leave the campus at any time.
2. Be careful crossing the streets on the campus.
3. If you bring a cell phone, we expect you to be courteous. This includes no talking or texting during classes.
