Dear Student and Parents:

Congratulations on your selection of the Rangerette Dance and Drill Team Clinic at Kilgore College. New this year, check in will be at the **Rangerette Showcase** located on Broadway Boulevard on the Kilgore College campus between 10 and 11 a.m. on the first day of your selected session. You can leave your bags in the car during check in. If you are unable to arrive during that time, please check in at the front desk of **Stark Hall** which is the dorm we will be using this year.

When you check in that morning, you will be given your dorm room assignment. Your dorm room assignment should not be changed. From the Rangerette Showcase, go to the dorm floor assigned to meet your chaperone, find your room, and unpack. (SH = Stark Hall)

At registration for those who owe a balance on tuition, please be prepared to pay that amount with a money order or cashier's check made payable to Rangerettes Forever, cash, or with a credit card (MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover). Personal checks will not be accepted at this time. Also, if a copy of your insurance card has not been sent previously, please turn in a copy of it at this time.

We request that parents, friends, and students agree not to have telephone calls during class time. We expect participants not to leave campus during their stay at Kilgore College.

Please note that if rules are not adhered to, participants will be sent home prior to the end of the clinic.

You will need the following: shorts or dance apparel, aerobic tennis shoes, jazz and/or lyrical shoes, and spending money. **For final demonstration, you will need any black dance attire and appropriate shoes for lyrical, jazz, etc.**

There will be a collection of souvenir items, as well as clothing for sale. Proceeds from these items go towards scholarships for our Rangerettes.

For your dorm room, bring sheets that would fit an extra long twin size bed or a twin size bed (some rooms have extra long twin beds), pillow, blanket, towels, soap, etc. Please bring some shoes that you can wear while taking a shower. We recommend you do not bring valuables, jewelry, etc. Keep your money with you at all times as the dorm rooms are not allowed to be locked. Everyone will need to check out of the dorm on the last day of their clinic.

Parents, family and friends are invited to a final demonstration to be held on the last day of your clinic in **Masters Gymnasium at 11 a.m.** Guests are asked not to walk on the Masters Gym floor.

You are in for an exciting week. Plenty of planning is going into it right now. Adult chaperones will be present both day and night. At night we also have a security guard on site. There will be something special going on every night. And, yes, you will be asked to get some rest.

We'll see you at the Rangerette Dance and Drill Team Clinic.

Clinic Info:

1. The name of your dorm and room number will be given to you when you arrive. ASH@ is Stark Hall. Please check in with your chaperone on your floor. Then take your suitcases to your room and unpack.
2. Our clinic officially starts with lunch.
3. **Wear your name tag at all times.** This will be given to you at check in.
4. **Keep your money with you at all times.** Do not leave it in your room.
5. Cooperate fully with your chaperone. She is responsible for you.

Dorm Rules:

1. Keep your room and dorm lobby clean. Nothing should be put on the walls of your room or on doors. This is the home of our students during school.
