- **Download all the tryout documents on the web site and READ several times BEFORE completing your tryout application and submitting.**
- Complete the online Rangerette Tryout Application, and submit with photos as soon as possible. This indicates you are planning to attend Rangerette Pre-Training and Tryouts, July 4-10, 2020.
- Contact the Kilgore College Office of Admissions to apply for admission to Kilgore College.

- To secure a room for the fall semester, download the housing application from <http://www.kilgore.edu> and return with the appropriate deposit (see housing application for amount). This IS NOT your payment for pre-training. If you do not make Rangerettes and are still planning on attending Kilgore College you must have a housing application and deposit on file to secure dorm space. - **(Strongly Recommended)** Maintain your performance stamina and physical conditioning. **We cannot stress enough how important it is for you to stretch and KICK DAILY to ensure a positive tryout experience. KICKING IS VERY IMPORTANT!**
- **(Strongly Recommended)** **Work out and include cardio in your plan. Look your BEST at tryouts. DO NOT WAIT until a month before tryouts to start thinking about this.**
- **(Optional)** Attend Rangerette Summer Camp. Attendance at camp is not mandatory; however, it has proven to be very beneficial for many Rangerette Hopefuls. There is NO difference between the two sections of HS camp. Same material is taught at both.
