mother, Shalia Deason Pybas, was a 1964–66 Rangerette.

"I attended my first KC
Homecoming at 6 months old,
so Kilgore College has always
been in my blood and been like
a second home," Gorman said.
"My parents' home was always
open to students, particularly athletes, so it just seemed
natural that I would work here
eventually. When I started at
KC, I was seeking a career closer to home to be there more
for my then almost-1-year-old
daughter ... and Kilgore College
allowed me that opportunity."

In her newest role, Gorman is revitalizing the Kilgore College Alumni Association, a project Jamerson started before she retired. Gorman said she hopes to build a robust Alumni Association with 300 or more members and develop regional alumni groups throughout the state (see "Join the Kilgore College Alumni Association," this page).

said. "Most alumni remember their four-year schools but forget about the community college that gave them their start."

Gorman also works with existing and potential scholar-ship donors and continues to work with the Kilgore College Foundation and its board of directors — along with a new executive director of development, Askala Harris — to find new funding resources for the college, she said.

"I love working with our scholarship donors and connecting them with students who benefit so much from their generosity," Gorman said. "I am not sure people realize just how huge the impact of their scholarship dollars (is) to these students ... I mean, truly life-changing."

Among those scholarship recipients are Kilgore College Rangerettes, whom Gorman has watched her entire life.


"It is interesting to see the 'behind the scenes' of how Rangerettes work," she said. "The general public really has no idea how hard these girls and their directors work because they make everything look so easy. People have no idea how blessed we are to have this organization here in Kilgore, Texas, and at Kilgore College. They are truly amazing to work with, and I consider myself so lucky to be associated with such a prestigious organization."

When those Rangerettes transition to Forevers, Gorman is a tie back to Kilgore College.

"I am here to help in any way I can, whether it's connecting to anything on campus or working on a new scholarship opportunity at the college," she said. "I want to be a link for all of our alumni back to Kilgore College." *






